Our Lehigh Valley has experienced some serious cold so far this winter. At this writing, it looks like January 2025 could go down as the second coldest January in the last 25 years. So, to provide some contextual comfort for cold weather worries—and maybe help to brighten those February Blues a bit—consider these extreme Winter Weather Whoppers recorded right here in our own Lehigh Valley. (Maybe you even remember some of them...all of us 769528 here at Deiter Bros. sure do!)

COLDEST DAY: -15 Degrees F. - January 21, 1994

COLDEST MONTH: 6.2 Degrees F. Average Temperature for <u>All</u> of February, 1934

The normal seasonal snowfall for ALL winter here in the Lehigh Valley is 32.9 inches. This blast almost matched it in just 24 hours.

The sole grid operator in Pennsylvania, PJM Interconnection, is forecasting a wave of power plant closures driven by Federal and State policies. According to PJM, more than 20% of total power generating capacity is at risk of closing by 2030. Simultaneously, electricity demand is expected to rise by 25% by 2030.

"The combination of soaring demand and shrinking supply spells skyrocketing electricity prices and deadly blackouts for Pennsylvania...as a result, Pennsylvanians' electricity bills could double in the next year, and that's just the beginning." Source: National Review—October 13, 2024. "The vast majority of Pennsylvania's electricity comes from fossil fuels. Renewables are great but there is nowhere near enough supply to fulfill Pennsylvania's growing energy demands," states James G. Deiter, President and CEO of Deiter Bros. Heating Cooling Energy, based in Bethlehem, PA. "Unfortunately, our government policymakers have electrification aspirations that ignore all current metrics, industry projections and common sense."
