# **1929** Deiter Bros. Celebrates 80 Years of Serving Lehigh

Funny, we don't feel 80 years old. But 2009 will be our family's 80th year serving local families and businesses. To give you a glimpse back at a bit of history, I've assembled a few photos from our family album. I hope you enjoy them. Thanks for the opportunity to serve you in the past...and well into the future.



The original Deiter Bros. —Sam and Bill Deiter—started as an ice delivery company serving families in Bethlehem. (Remember, this was before refrigerators. "Iceboxes" used real blocks of ice to keep food cold.) This shot is from the late 1930s when we had moved from the 240820 south side of Bethlehem to our current location on Stefko Blvd. By then, we had added coal to our product line. But as you can see by the sign, ice delivery was still a standby. And check out the surface of Stefko Blvd...we needed those rugged trucks to handle the rough road surfaces back then!



To keep the Deiter Bros. name on hand with customers, we gave away these ice picks. Years ago we found this one and saved it for the archives. The phone number on the back of the handle read "Phone 3426".



Anthracite coal was king for heating in the Lehigh Valley, as you can see from this view of the Deiter Bros. coal yards. But by the early 1950s, fuel oil was starting to make the scene as a cleaner, more convenient way to stay cozy. And Deiter Bros. changed with the times...note the early oil storage tanks in the background.



Coal and service trucks on the left...oil trucks on the right. Here's a view of our service fleet from the 1950's. That building on the far right was Pembroke Dress Co.; it's where our neighbor Just Born's property line is today. The quonset hut design proved big enough to house multiple trucks for their maintenance. Not too pretty but it has served us well up to the present day.

### Holiday & Winter Security Tips What if a Stranger Comes to Your Door?



I hate to be grinch-like about this, but the reality is that this lousy economy has more criminals out on the streets, desperate and looking to take advantage of homeowners any way they can. And the holidays are a time when folks are feeling generous...a perfect time for ill-willed thieves to strike. 255465

Crooks sometimes pose as couriers delivering gifts. If you don't see a real delivery truck out front (UPS, FedEx, flower delivery, etc.) take a look at the "delivery" person through a peephole or other window. (If you can't get a glance at who is outside your door, it's high time you had a viewing device installed!) If the person is not uniformed or appears suspicious in any way, do not open the door until they hold up company ID to the viewing window.

It's also not uncommon for crooks of all ages kids to oldsters—to go door-to-door for holiday donations when there's no legitimate charity involved. Ask for identification and find out how the funds are to be used. Ask for some type of printed material on the organization or cause. All legitimate charities have some type of printed material on their cause. If ID or print are missing, don't give..chances are you're being scammed.



### Here are more "SAFETY SMART" tips for the holidays:

#### **WHILE YOU ARE SHOPPING:**

Stay alert and aware of what's going on around you. Park in well-lit spaces. Lock the car, close the windows and hide shopping bags and gifts in the trunk. Don't overburden yourself with packages. Keep an eye on your purse at all times and keep it close to your body...not dangling on straps. Avoid carrying large amounts of cash...pay by check or credit card whenever possible. 35768

### **\* PROTECT YOUR VEHICLE:**

Don't leave gifts (or anything of value!) inside your car where thieves can see them. There's been a rash of thefts from cars throughout the Lehigh Valley. The crooks have been very bold about smashing into cars to take GPS systems, laptops, briefcases, CDs, spare change AND gifts. Don't become a victim...remember: out of sight, out of mind.

### lpha AFTER YOU'VE OPENED YOUR

**GIFTS:** Don't put the boxes that electronic equipment and other expensive gifts came in out in the trash right away. This only makes it easier for thieves to know exactly what's inside your home. Break down the boxes and store them in the basement or garage until after the holidays...then put them in

garbage bags and out for the trash in the evening before your regular trash pickup.
