Fall & Winter WEATHER FORECASTS

Remember all the rain we had in 2011? Imagine if it was snow, like we got socked with on Halloween weekend only followed by days of freezing cold. Here's what the Weather Wizards at The Old Farmer's Almanac are calling for during the upcoming cold months here in our Lehigh Valley:

NOVEMBER

Although many of us were still without power due to the "Halloween Screamer" snowstorm, the rest of this month won't be as, uh, dramatic weatherwise. Button up for bright but cold days and nights with a thankful, but wet, break from the bitterness for the long Thanksgiving weekend.

DECEMBER

It could be a white Christmas this year as intermittent showers kick off the month and the first serious snowfall

around the 17th to 20th and potential for additional snows 81844 providing tough sledding for Santa during the Christmas stretch. We bid farewell to 2011 with either rain or wet snow making for some slippery streets on New Year's Eve.

JANUARY



2012 is predicted to be 5°F warmer than average with sun and rain trading the spotlight until midmonth when the snowfalls start to come with increasing frequency and intensity. Our region's first real snow blizzard will bury the Valley on the 30th to 31st. Be prepared.



FEBRUARY

1. CALIBRATED BLOWER DOOR TEST

A calibrated blower door is a specialized fan-driven diagnostic tool that we temporarily mount into the frame of an exterior door. The fan pulls air out of the house, lowering the air pressure

inside. The higher outside air pressure then flows in through all unsealed cracks and openings. Several gauges on the blower door perform diagnostic tests throughout to determine the air infiltration rate of your home.



2. THERMOGRAPHIC INSPECTION

Using specially-designed thermographic infrared instruments, we check the effectiveness of the home's insulation and construction "skin" which keeps cold out in winter, and coolness in during summer. Images on the video record temperature
